Colin Carlson may be young, but he's got a big message: Save energy to save the world.

The 12-year-old from Coventry, Conn., runs the Cool Coventry Club. The club teaches people how to **conserve**, or save, energy. More than 600 families have joined Colin's club. The student recently won a Gloria Barron Prize for Young Heroes for his work.



Each member of the Cool Coventry Club has to promise to use less energy in at least three ways. "The changes can help people save money and Earth at the same time," Colin says.
